Dear Parents/Carers,

Update re COVID-19 Cases at School

Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work through our first couple of positive COVID cases at school.

Please be assured we are following the direct advice from the Department of Health and the Department of Education and Training as we manage this situation.

All potential Personal Close Contacts have been notified and as expected, cooperation in terms of testing and isolation has been high.

It is also reassuring to know that we have been funded for additional cleaning, which has been in place for many months now.

Overall school attendance has been low this week and I encourage students who are not isolating to return to school as soon as possible. We have comprehensive and thorough processes in place that we will follow in the event of another positive case.

I encourage all families to seek medical advice in relation to vaccination. At this stage, the isolation period for vaccinated people who are Personal Close Contacts is 7 days as opposed to 14 days for unvaccinated people.
